Kruger national Park

Kruger National Park, in northeastern South Africa, is one of Africa's largest game reserves.

Its high density of wild animals includes the Big 5: lions, leopards, rhinos, elephants and buffalos.

Hundreds of other mammals make their home here, as do diverse bird species such as vultures, eagles and storks. Being the biggest national park in South Africa, visitors can expect an abundance of wildlife sightings

Mountains, bush plains and tropical forests are all part of the landscape.

The Kruger National Park boasts outstanding biodiversity and world-class game viewing with around 147 mammals, 49 fish, 34 amphibian, 114 reptile and 507 bird species. Visitors can expect to see the Big 5, the Little 5, the Birding Big 6, and a vast array of special animals such as wild dogs and cheetahs.
